As it is a new financial year all absences have been reduced to 41. This means you can only have 41 days absences without a reason, and this includes Public Holidays. If you go to a Doctor please get a certificate as we can use that once your child has used up their days and this doesn't count towards absences.


#### **Fees**

The children have been continuing to develop their fine motor skills over the last few weeks and making such beautiful creations with the activity's that have been provided.




The children have enjoyed playing outside with a range of different
