If your child has borrowed spare clothes don't forget to return them.

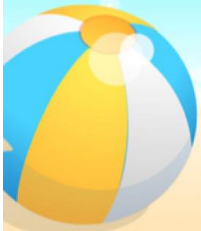
This month we have been very busy doing puzzle, threading with beads, playing role play with dress ups and reading stories. This is helping us to learn so many new things.
